Activities the children will take part in will include:

- English: Narrative, Recounts

- Art & Design: Mixing Primary colours- Fire picture

Vocabulary for Topic

Some vocabulary that your child should know for our Topic is,

Great Fire of London, London, capital city, firefighters, St Pauls Cathedral, Samuel Pepys, diary, changes over time, eyewitness, significant event, Pudding Lane, Bakery, Thomas Farriner, 1666, timeline, past and present, jobs

Vocabulary for English

Some vocabulary that your child should know for English is,

Capital letters, full stops, finger spaces, narrative, story, beginning, middle, end, good/ bad characters, sentences, recounts, first, second, third, then, next, finally, 1st person, sequence

Vocabulary for Maths

Some vocabulary that your child should know for Maths is

Positional language, above, on top, underneath, next to, beside, left, right, in front, behind, turns, quarter turn to the left, quarter turn to the right, half turn, full turn, three quarter turn, clockwise, anti-clockwise, ordinal numbers – 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, repeating pattern, subitising, place value, tens and ones

Vocabulary for Science

Some vocabulary that your child should know for Science is

Seasonal changes, autumn, winter, spring, summer, changes, trees, leaves, weather, temperature, clothes, rainfall, months of the year, seasons Living things and their habitats, micro habitats, living, dead, never alive, woodland, grassland, coastal, growth, life processes, food chains

Over this half term please pick a home learning task.
