In the second half term we will be studying Mountains in Geography.




We are architects - Creating a virtual space. After half term We are VR designers - Experimenting with virtual and augmented reality. Both units have an Information Technology focus.

In Art. children will be learning about landscape artists and techniques for perspective in artwork.




We have two Christianity based units this term. We will be asking what does it mean if God is loving and holy and exploring the concept of Jesus as the Messiah.



In maths we will cover:


- Place value

- Fractions




We will be setting goals, exploring global citizenship and learning about human rights.
