This term, Class 4 will be working on the topic 'The Maya Civilization' which will look into the History of the Maya people and the impact they had on the world



Design and Technology

The children will be preparing and cooking a Mexican inspired dish



Science

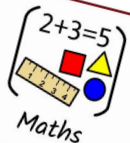
This term in science we are looking at life processes and living things with a focus on life cycles and reproduction of plants and animals.

We will be exploring rhythmic and melodic patterns, singing, chords and using baselines and riffs.



Music

This term in maths we will be looking at written methods of all four operations; shape and space; statistics; and decimals and percentages.

We will be exploring our dreams and goals and learning what we need to be healthy.

We will be making sense of the internet and building a website. Then we will be developing our digital literacy by creating a short television advert.



Computing

This term in art we will be studying and creating portraits. We will examine historical portraits and learn to draw facial features and create our own in different media.



Art

In RE we will be studying the Hindu belief of Moksha. We will be asking what spiritual pathways to Moksha are written about in Hindu scriptures?



Religious Education

In English this term we will be looking at books which cover themes of affirmation and equality. We will also be studying myths and legends

Geography

In PE we will be studying gymnastics including rhythmic, balance and equipment sequences.
