

Gale Warning!

When the air moves about we say that the wind is blowing. Sometimes the air moves slowly and we get a gentle breeze. Sometimes it moves very quickly and storms and hurricanes occur.

In 1805, a British admiral called Sir Francis Beaufort worked out what happened at sea when the air moved at different speeds. The Beaufort Scale was adapted for the effects of wind on land and is still in use today.
