 *Then pick up speed over Piccadilly*

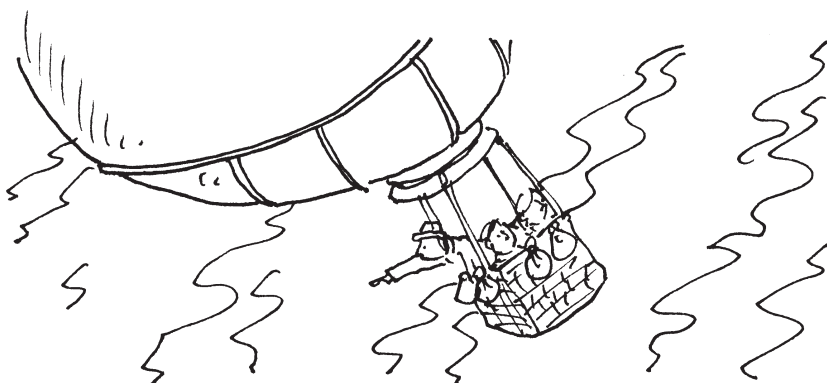
Now hold on tight – we're drifting down
