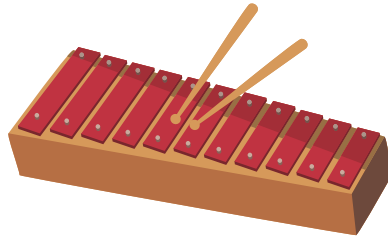

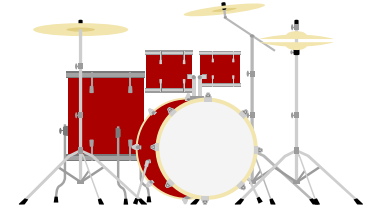

- Hitch a ride





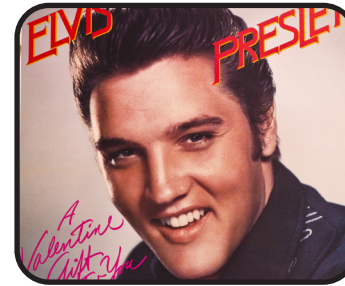
