Spellings

Spellings are done differently in class 4.

Children have their own unique words that they are learning to spell. These are taken from HFW, then Year 3 & 4 words, then the Year 5 & 6 words. We also take spelling mistakes from their writing including misuse of homophones.

Most children have 15 spellings on the go at all times. They practise in school twice a week and are tested once a week. There is a sliding scale of how many they change.
